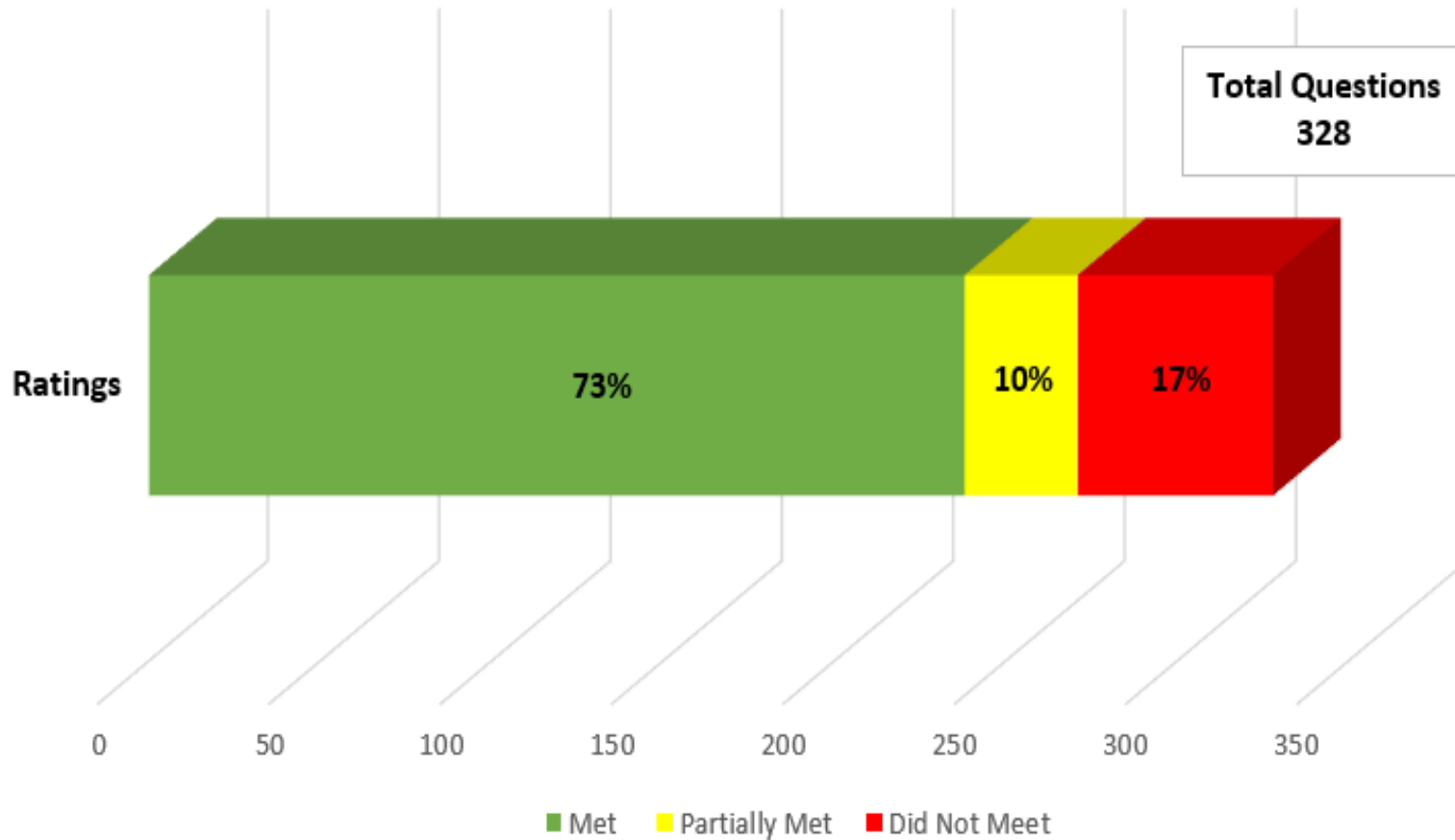

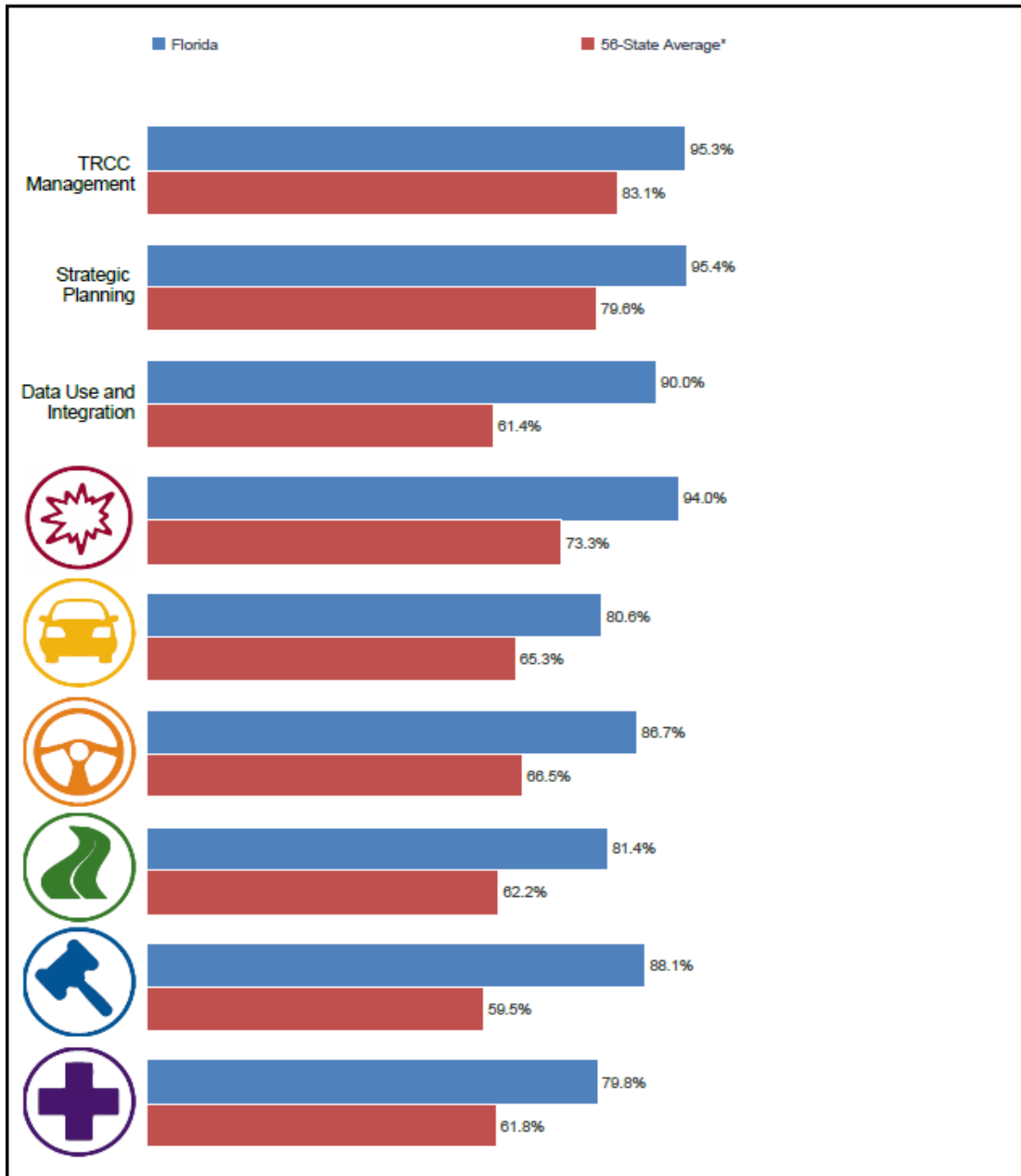

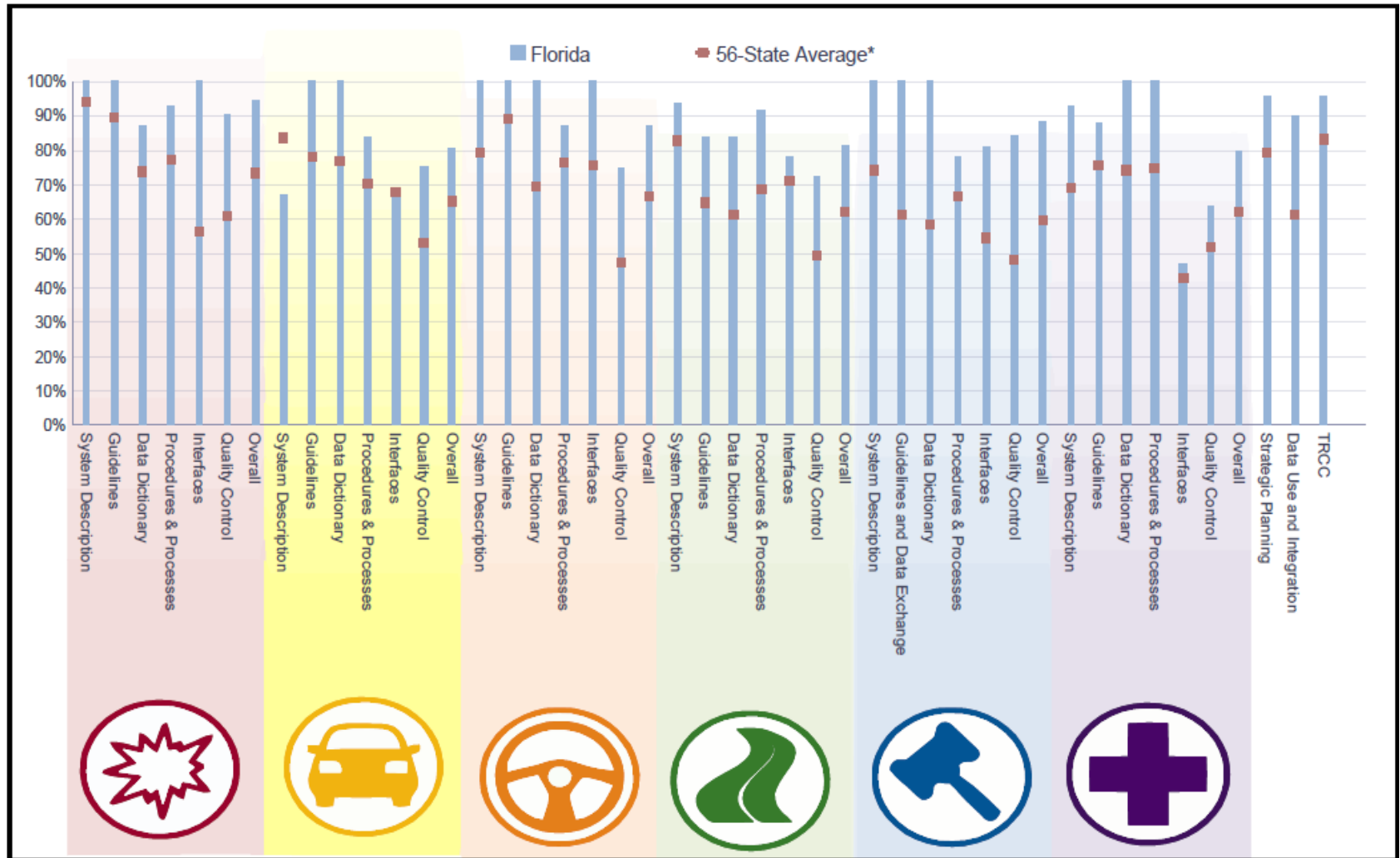

Florida Strengths

- Enterprise roadway system with single LRS and collection of multiple FDEs for all public roads
- Involvement of all aspects of a comprehensive injury surveillance system

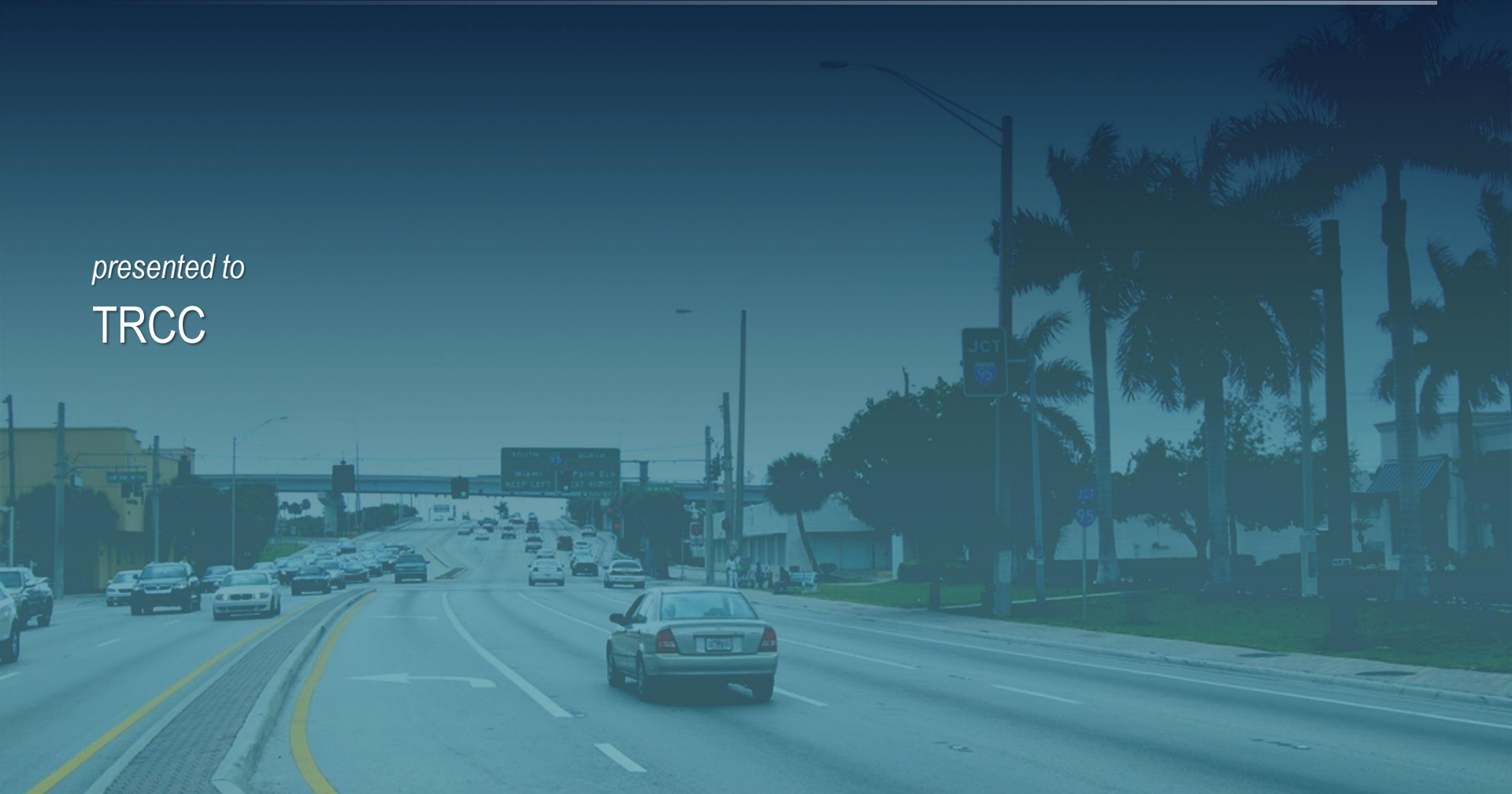
